#### **Eligibility**

Competitors must hold a current 2025-2026 USSS Alpine Master Membership or a \$35 short term Alpine Master Membership for the races on January 19th. A short term membership is ideal for racers unsure if they will be able to attend more races this season.

There will be more opportunities than ever for Masters to race in Oregon this season including Bachelor and the summer Wy'East Cup. Consider a full license! Deadline for the full license is October 15, 2025. You can also get a short term license for any race and upgrade without penalty or late fees.
