Make sure to sign the on-line Timberline liability release (see link on the race flier). **Bib numbers will be different for this race. Use your PACRAT bib number if you raced PACRAT. If you didn't race PACRAT you will be assigned a bib number at check-in on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the lodge between 8:00 and 8:45AM.** Your first four runs (alternating courses) will count toward the Terry Walter Condor Cup standings and then you are welcome to take as many additional runs as you want until the course is closed/pulled.
