
President's Corner:

The Club Championships – Snow Bird: We had great weather for this year's club championships March 23rd at Meadows. We were on Middle Fork! We had 39 racers including 9 in the always competitive A class and 4 in our 70+ age Vet V/Sr. B class. Most were able to complete two runs. The course held up great. Jesse Scroggins edged Adam Miller to claim fastest overall (and winner of Class A) by just 0.47 seconds. Other class winners were: Joe Smoot (B) (Bruce Parshall gets on the trophy

since Joe was an associate at the race), Jim McGinn (C) (Dennis Noreen gets on the trophy since Jim was an associate at the race), Farzin Ghezel (Sr. A), Harrison Brown (Vet I), Justin Bishop (Vet II), Bob Brown (Vet III), and Dexter Hill (Sr. B). Results are on the website and were sent in an earlier email.

After the Club Championships the course was reset for the Snow Bird race. Dave Mills was able to navigate the course fastest and claim the Snow Bird crown and he won Dan Lane \$198 in the Calcutta (that's two years in a row for Dan).

Thanks to Ed and the rest of the race crew for the great courses, Greg Dilger for being our crossing guard, and our Skiyente friends for help with starting, gate keeping and timing.
