Rules

Mulligans = Ladies 2 per 6-hole game

Mulligans = Men 1 per 6-hole game

KPS on ALL par 3's for men and women

Long Drive #3 Thistle and #2 on Pine Cone for both men and ladies

KP's must be on the green, long drives in the fairway

**** Mulligans can't be used for KPs or Long Drives

Holes 1-6 Kind of like Best Ball

Both players hit off the tee, men on white and ladies on red, pick the best drive and both players play from there. After hitting your second shot you must play your own ball the rest of the way into the hole. Mark down the lowest score between the two players.

Holes 7-12 is Alternating Golf Shots

This is easy (NOT REALLY!!) Both players hit off their tee, pick the best drive and the person who did NOT hit that drive must hit the next shot. The other player must hit the next shot after that, and you must continue to alternate each shot until you are in the hole, and that would be your score.

Holes 13-18 is the Couple Scramble

Both players hit off the tee, pick the best drive and both players hit from that spot. Take the next best shot and both players play from there. Keep doing this until you hole out and that would be your score. Are you done breathing hard and ready for food and drink? Here is the answer.
