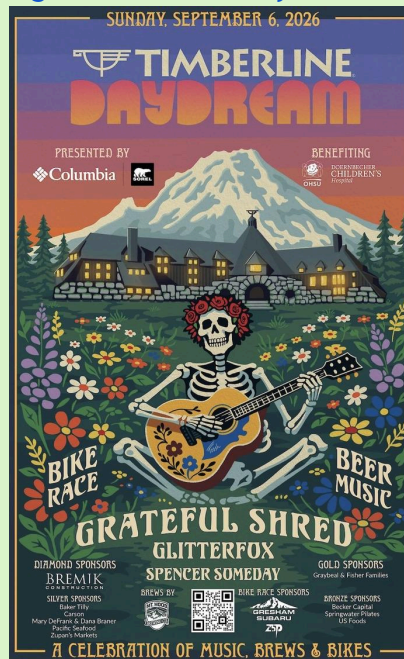

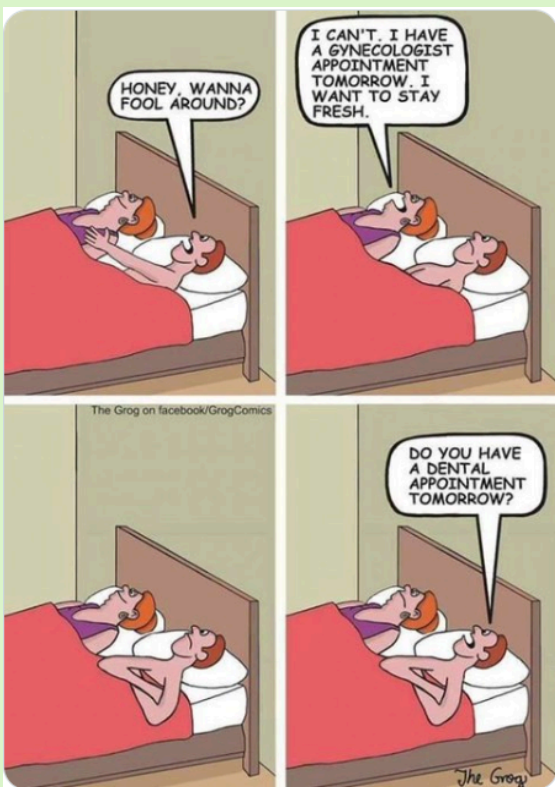
SVSC SWAG
